The Board of Commissioners for Mayes County is considering applying to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce's Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development Infrastructure Financing Program (CDBG-EDIF) for funding assistance. The State of Oklahoma has funds available to units of local government to undertake viable economic development activities that primarily benefit persons defined as low and moderate income.

Economic development has been identified as a community/county priority need and a tentative decision has been made to seek funding from the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for federal/state funds to extend water service to Trécé Incorporated by installing a new 8" PVC line approximately 13,500 linear feet along with associated valves, boxes, stream crossings, road crossings, connections, hydrants, engineering design, inspection and administration of said project.

According to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce's income guidelines, the project will benefit at least 51% low- and moderate-income residents.

The purpose of this public hearing is to enable comments on the specific project activities that are proposed and to provide a clear explanation of the probable impacts on the county and residents should the project be funded.

Many specific details regarding eligible activities and program requirements will be provided at a public hearing which will be held at Mayes County Board of Commissioners' Room, 1 Court Place, Pryor, OK on
